## Quiltrick #15:

I like to use various methods of appliqué: needle turn, starch, fused with raw edge... A friend of mine (Nancy) who is incredible at appliqué shared her starch method with me recently. She draws her image onto freezer paper and then irons two or three layers of the freezer paper together. This gives her a firm edge around which she can press her starched fabric. Best of all, the freezer paper doesn't distort and can be used again several times.

It has been a summer of beginnings and endings. My daughter got married and began a new life with her husband. I made her veil without incident! I became a mother-in-law and even started working on a few new quilt designs which I hope to debut this fall. As for endings, my local quilt shop has decided to close after 37 years in business. A second home for many, Etcetera Crafts will be greatly missed.

In the past few years, my local guild has sponsored a raffle quilt to benefit a charity in the Raleigh area. This year the quilt top, an antique grandmother's flower garden, was donated.
